

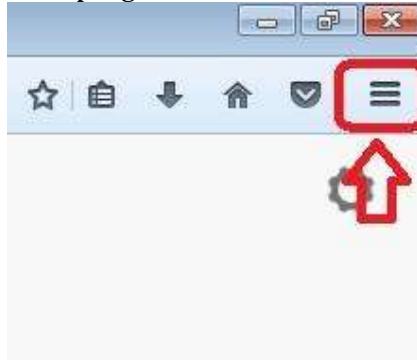

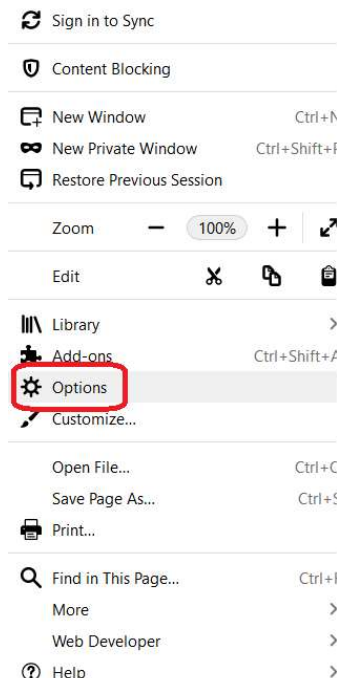
How to delete unwanted copies of your digital certificates from windows computer

I. Deleting from Mozilla browser Key store

1. Launch you Mozilla Firefox browser then click on the menu icon found at the top right corner of the screen. Select Options

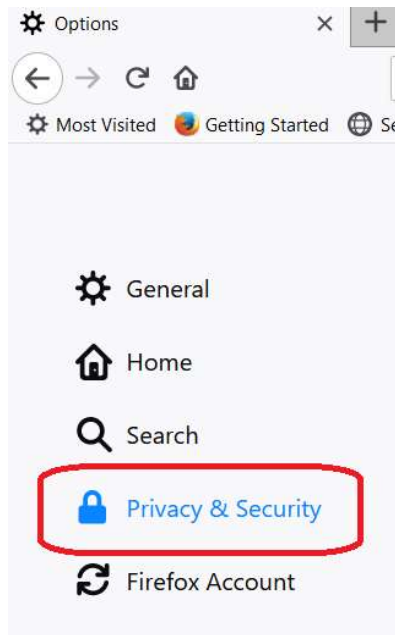


2. At the Option pages, click on Advanced from the left-hand menu. Note: Depending on your version of Mozilla, sometimes this menu is found at the top of the page instead of the left side.





3. At the Option window, click on Privacy & Security

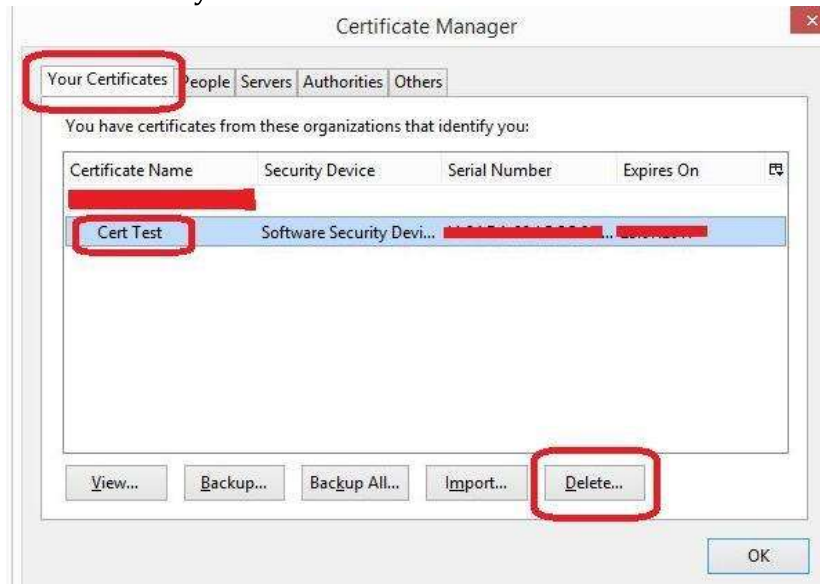


4. Scroll down to the bottom of the page to find the section for Certificates.
Click on the View Certificates button.





- At the Certificate Manager window, go to the Your Certificates tab, highlight the certificates you want to delete then click on Delete



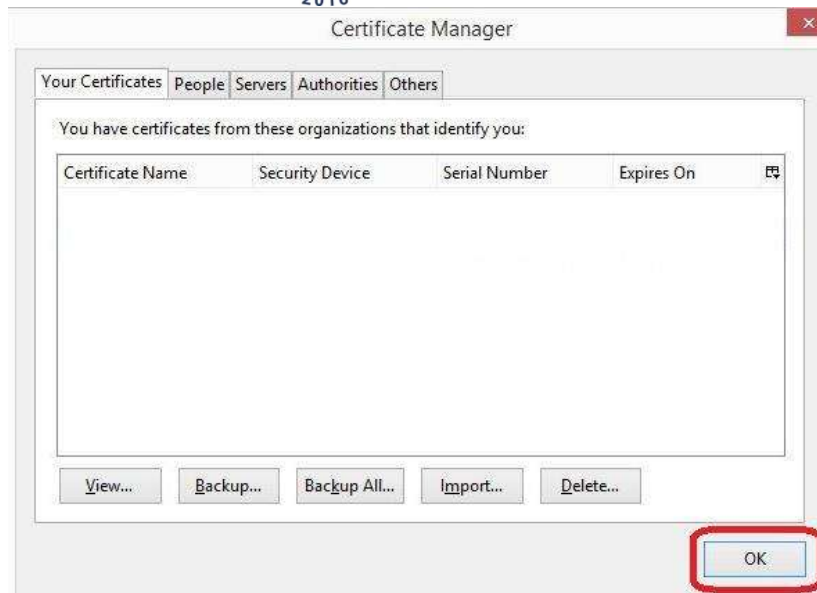
- A confirmation window will appear. Just click OK to confirm



- Your certificate has been removed, click on OK to close out the window

II. Deleting from your Windows Keystore

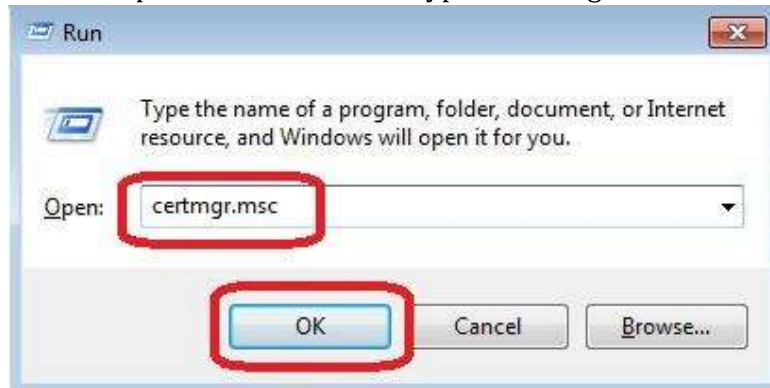
1. Press on the Windows key and the letter R on your keyboard simultaneously





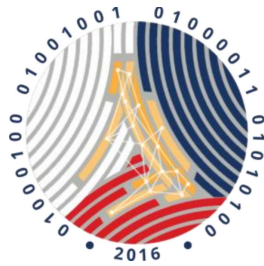

2. This will open the run window. Type in certmgr.msc then click on OK



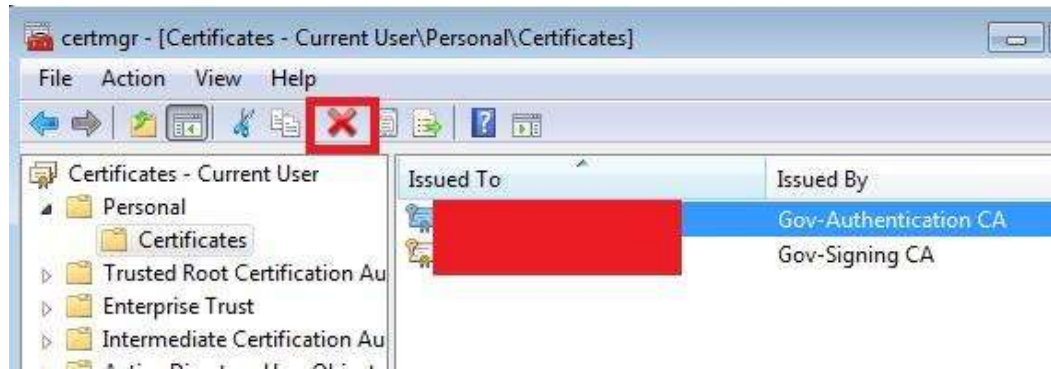
3. At the certmgr window, double click on the Personal folder. Next double click on the Certificates folder.

4. Highlight the certificates you want to delete the click on the “X” or you can simply press on the delete button on the keyboard



5. A confirmation window will appear, just click on yes to confirm deletion



6. Once finish deleting all the certificates you don't need, you can just close out the window
